## **New Trick Procedure for 2019**

WIII DE :	declared but flexible, a repeated trick can score - but will be counted within the 14 first tricks		1	1 plus 2nd chance (could be a repeated pass or completely different)	

Generally Positions (standard basic 180 turns hand and toehold) will not count to the first 14 Tricks except :

- 1) You do minimum 2 consecutive 180 basic tricks (eg. a Front and a Back)
- 2) If you have positions within the first 14 Tricks when have fall or the tricks run ends at the pulley Skier may offer 2 different declared passes for the final to the calculator before start

## Alexander Isaev is in discussion with skiers about the Trick Values

- Value of Tricks need to be balanced, we don't want to have uniformity trick runs :
  - Toehold higher ?
  - Bodyover Higher ?
  - Higher points for more complex Tricks in general?
  - → Prepare Proposals on fully programs with todays values
  - → Prepare comparable trick sequences
- Limitation to 6 Flips :
  - 6 Flips is a good balance out of 14 Tricks in total
  - Bad performed flips need to be penalized more strictly
- Beside the 2nd chance, we need to be faster in showing the results on the website of the passes in general, but we not wait for the second pass because of missing results
