Accommodation and food

Official accommodation is Menorah business center.
There are two options available:

- 1) 7 Days City Hotel – cozy and more than affordable.
Each room can fit up to 3 people. The price of the room is 600 HRN (approx. 20 EUR) despite the number of people. Breakfast is not included. Number of rooms is limited. Booking code is "group1511".
- 2) Menorah Hotel. Single room is 1340 HRN (approx. 45 EUR)
Double room is 1600 HRN (approx. 55 EUR)
Breakfast is included. Booking code is "group1877".

Arriving to Dnepropetrovsk

Your destination airport is Dnepropetrovsk International (DNK). Plenty of different airlines fly there. The airport is 11 km from Sentosa park and 16 km from the official Hotel Menorah. Transfers from the airport may be organized by demand and will have to be paid to Organizer upon arrival. Please, contact Maria Korol' at maria.korol.sentosa@gmail.com. If not pre-arranged by organizer, you will still be able to hire the taxi at arrival.

You may want to arrive to Kiev Boryspil Airport (KBP) and take express train from Kiev railway station to Dnepropetrovsk. There is a bus going from Boryspil airport to Kiev railway station. Please, check the link for more information and schedule <https://kbp.aero/en/transport/sky-bus/>.

Express trains to Dnepropetrovsk run three times a day. The trip is about 5,5 hours long. Keep in mind that Dnepropetrovsk is not the last stop. Please, check timetable here: <http://uz.gov.ua/en/passengers/timetable/>.

The distance between Dnepropetrovsk railway station and the Hotel is less than 5 km. Transfers can be organized on demand.



Entries

Intention to Enter forms must be submitted to the Organizer at bumaria@gmail.com no later than June 25th.

Entry forms must be sent to the Organizer and the Council representative no later than August 5th.

Entry fee is 120 EUR per skier in Junior division and 160 EUR per skier in Open and Senior divisions. This must be paid to Organizer at team registration.

Rule 2: Confederation E&A (European) Cableski Championships

Rule 2.5: Non-team skiers

Skiers not selected for their national team may qualify to compete in the Confederation E&A Cableski Championships as individuals if they meet one or more of the following criteria:

- *Reigning Confederation E&A Cableski Champion in that event (Slalom, Tricks or/and Jump) in which they defend their title.*
- *Ranked on one IWWF Confederation E&A Cableski WBW Ranking List of the past year in the top 10% men or women in any event excluding overall. The WBW Ranking List has a one year rolling system and the closing date for the title event will be announced by beginning of the season. 51*

Confederation E&A Cableski Additional Rules 2016 / Version 1

The numbers will be rounded to the nearest full digit.

All skiers qualified as individuals must be entered by their federation.
