All skiers will ski in one age category, being the 'Open' category. Every country will be allowed to select up to 10 athletes for each of the stops of ITC (women and men together). The names of the selected skiers will be communicated by the national federation, by sending the entry document (see appendix 1), to the organizer of the ITC stop ( [itc@twincable-beckum.de](mailto:itc@twincable-beckum.de) ) and a copy to the Cableski Council.

### ***SAFETY***

### ***ENTRY REQUIREMENTS***

Every country will be allowed to select up to 10 athletes for each of the stops of ITC (women and men together).

### ***FORMAT***

Finals will be held with 12 Open Men and 8 Open Ladies per discipline.

### ***REGISTRATION DEADLINE***

The registration deadline will be **4<sup>th</sup> of September 2016 on 23:59 CET.**

### ***ENTRY FEE***

The organizer demands an entry fee of 100€ for all 3 disciplines, 90€ for two and 60€ for one discipline which can be paid online on [www.twincable-beckum.de](http://www.twincable-beckum.de) under „Online Buchung“ and Events. Registration after the registration deadline can't be guaranteed and is connected with a late fee of 20€ for each discipline.

The organizer excludes any liability for skiers, judges, officials, helpers and other persons for any personal or material damage.

Every competitor (official) takes part on her/his own risk, even if they perform in show competitions or programs not part of the official competition. By signing the entry form skiers and officials resign any claim of damage, consequential or direct, that results from the competition.

Active participants should have a private insurance in addition to their health insurance. Third-party damage (e.g. damages to fans or spectators) is insured only by the organizer's liability.

(Discharge from liability: The official paper to discharge the club from liability must be signed by each skier before he/she begins training)

***LOCATION***

The recreational Tutenbrock has its devotees known as lake with excellent water quality. For many years, the turquoise water of the old cement underground mining guests fascinated from the region and beyond. Located next to the highway exit of the A2, the lake offers a good goal to be achieved, its appeal will be enhanced by the tow for water skiing park. Two large opposing 5-pole systems, a Rixen Master 450 and a practice lift involve potential for all water skiing levels. Numerous features enhance sports opportunities of the Rixen systems. For all guests who do not want to get used to the sport, the terrain offers spacious green areas, sandy beach and swimming area. Refreshments round future from the options for visitors of the Twin Cable Beckum.



## ***ACCOMODATION***

### **Tent meadow**

You have the chance to sleep on our tent meadow straight at the lake. Shower and toilets are available right next to cable. For each night there will be the following costs:

## ***APPROACH***

### **With the public transportation:**

The train station in Neubeckum is located 3,8km away from the Tutenbrocksee and is connected to all regional connections. With the public bus you can reach the venue easily from the train station.

### **With the car:**

The Tutenbrocksee is located straight at the highway A2 and can be reached perfectly by car. A sufficient car parking is available right at the lake free of charge.

From the West:

- On exit 20-Beckum on B475 in direction Beckum (on the right)
- After 350m go right on the street „Obere Breede“
- After 250m go right on the street „Am Tutenbrocksee“

From the East:

- On exit 20-Beckum on B475 in direction Beckum (on the right)
- After 400m go right on the street „Obere Breede“
- After 450m go right on the street „Am Tutenbrocksee“
